





# Members in Action

Advocating on behalf of farmers and ranchers is a priority of the Yuba-Sutter Farm Bureau. Members and staff engage in local, state, and national issues.

## Locally:

- Supported members by writing letters to the County Board of Supervisors in support of an appeal for development on agricultural land.
- Board members and staff represented YSFB at a California Air Resources Board meeting to discuss challenges with pending rules on electric forklifts and trucks.
- Members spoke to the media about issues impacting agriculture.
- YSFB endorsed agriculture-friendly candidates in the 2024 local election.
- The Yuba and Sutter County Economic Development divisions hosted a tour for foreign entrepreneurs. Members hosted tours for the group that highlighted the agriculture industry and advanced technologies.



## Statewide and Nationally:

- **Kulwant Johl received the California Farm Bureau Distinguished Service Award.**
- **Park Farming Organics received the Leopold Conservation Award.**
- Eight Farm Bureau members attended the California Farm Bureau Annual Meeting.
- Two members participated in the California Farm Bureau Leadership Farm Bureau Program.
- Six Farm Bureau members participated in the California Farm Bureau Commodity Advisory Committees. Members discuss how issues will impact commodities from throughout the state and make a policy recommendation to be adopted by the California Farm Bureau.
- Six members attended the Capitol Ag Conference in Sacramento. They joined more than 300 Farm Bureau members from throughout the state who met with state representatives to discuss important issues and encourage action on behalf of agriculture.
- Board members attended the California Farm Bureau annual trip to Washington D.C. with the Leadership Farm Bureau program. They met with legislators from across the country to discuss issues including the Farm Bill.

## Young Farmers & Ranchers

Young Farmers & Ranchers is a committee of the Farm Bureau for people involved in agriculture ages 18-35. The group provides networking opportunities through monthly meetings and social events.

In 2024 year, the group toured **eight different commodities** throughout the area, covering typical row crops and orchard trees, as well as specialty crops such as kiwis. These tours gave members the ability to ask questions to industry leaders to expand their agricultural knowledge and skills.

The group also participated in **Farm Day** and taught local youth about the crops grown in the area. A **Toys-for-Tots** drive was hosted by the members bringing in over 100 toys for low-income families in the area.

For fundraisers, we held a raffle at **Spring Fling** and a **Drive-Thru BBQ**. We also served at the **Sutter County Republicans dinner**. The funds are used to support local youth agricultural programs and provide scholarships.

In months without tours, we hosted socials where members could develop relationships with other members. These events consisted of a river float and our holiday party.



# Subwatersheds

In 2003, the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program (ILRP) was formed to regulate the discharge from irrigated agriculture for surface and groundwater to protect water quality. The Regional Water Quality Control Board is the regulator of the program.

Growers and landowners formed Coalitions to share the cost to comply and have assistance. The Coalitions report to Regional Water Quality Control Board.

The subwatershed groups were developed to support members, by region, comply with the ILRP. There are **11 subwatershed groups**. These groups report to the Coalitions.

The Butte-Yuba-Sutter Water Quality Coalition (BYSWQC) and the Placer-Nevada-South Sutter-North Sacramento Subwatershed Group (PNSSNS) are individual subwatershed groups within the Sacramento Valley Water Quality Coalition.

## Our services to our members include:

- Reporting assistance for more than **1700 growers**.
- Provided regulatory updates and clarification to members via email communications and one on one interactions.
- Coordinated educational opportunities including presentations at local grower meetings and training videos available on YouTube.
- Addressed pesticide exceedances that are harmful to water quality by working with growers, ag commissioners, and Sacramento Valley Water Quality Coalition.


